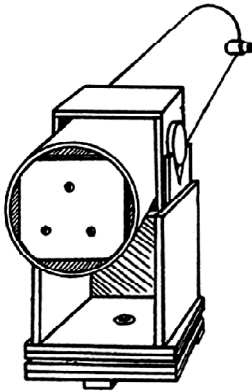




# The Young Astronomer's Telescope Scholarship Award Application Form

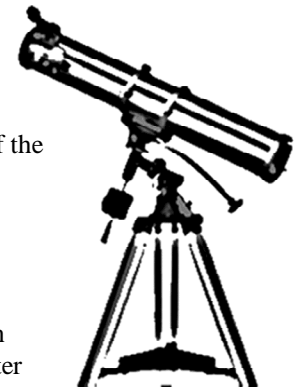

The recipient of this award will receive, for one year, a loaner telescope and supporting accessories from the Madison Astronomical Society (MAS). The telescopes are an 8 inch dobsonian reflector or a 4.5 inch equatorial reflector, with finderscope, eyepieces, star charts, and other assorted accessories.  
**Applicants must be in 9th through 12 grades for the 2005-06 school year.**

1. Attend the May 2005 meeting of the Madison Astronomical Society for presentation of the award
2. Attend the June 2005 MAS picnic to receive the telescope and be trained in its use.
3. During the period of the award, maintain contact with an MAS mentor (TBA) for any equipment maintenance needs or questions.
4. At the end of the award period, to provide a written or oral presentation to the Madison Astronomical Society. This may be a personal journal, an article for the MAS newsletter (*Capital Skies*), or a presentation at an MAS meeting.
5. Allow your name and photograph to be published in the newsletters or other publications of the MAS.
6. Turn in the telescope and all associated equipment prior to the May 2006 annual meeting of the MAS.
